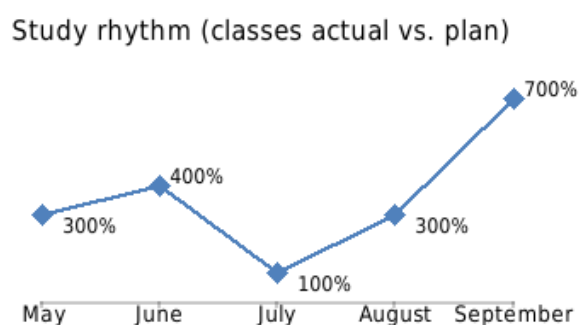
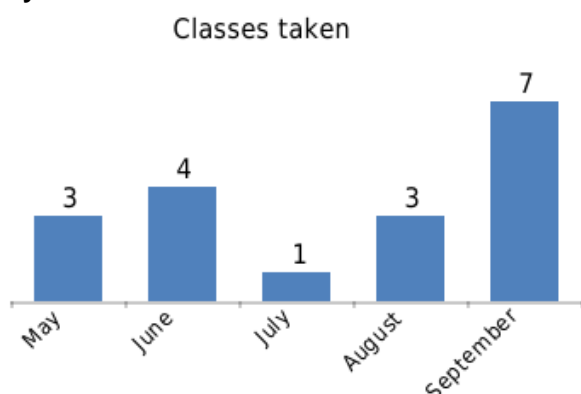

## Comments and recommendations:

### Comments on language progression and skills:
