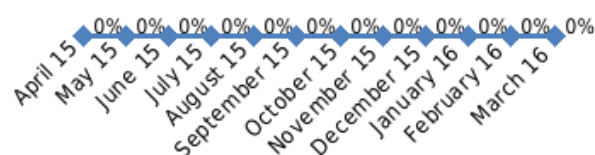

Comments on language progression and skills:

Barbara Fregosi made good progress in writing skills, confidence in speaking and listening and comprehension, conversational skills, vocabulary building / more sophisticated vocabulary / more extensive vocabulary, pronunciation, word stressing and intonation, good degree of fluency / expressing opinions on a variety of subjects with a good degree of fluency

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:

Throughout the course Barbara Fregosi made positive efforts to integrate the target language and concepts into the conversation, worked very hard to complete the tasks assigned, treated learning very seriously

Recommendations and next steps:

Some areas that still need improvement are vocabulary building, writing skills, speaking and listening skills, grammatical accuracy, fluency. I would therefore recommend that Barbara Fregosi continues to take lessons, once or twice per week, in order to maintain the level of self confidence and ensure continuous improvement.
