


Comments on language progression and skills:

Yusuke Uenishi made good progress in confidence in speaking and listening and comprehension, vocabulary building / more sophisticated vocabulary / more extensive vocabulary, establishing greater grammatical control / improving grammatical accuracy / better use and understanding of grammar, pronunciation, word stressing and intonation

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:
