


Comments on language progression and skills:

Keisuke Nakatsuka made good progress in confidence in speaking and listening and comprehension, expressing with high level of self confidence, conversational skills, accuracy in using more complex grammar structures for business situations, vocabulary building / more sophisticated vocabulary / more extensive vocabulary, awareness of cultural issues, establishing greater grammatical control / improving grammatical accuracy / better use and understanding of grammar, good degree of fluency / expressing opinions on a variety of subjects with a good degree of fluency, pronunciation, word stressing and intonation

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:

Throughout the course Keisuke Nakatsuka made positive efforts to integrate the target language and concepts into the conversation, always did more than requested and gave every lesson the best at all times, treated learning very seriously. Interaction and participation has been excellent attitude to learning. The student fully participated in the lessons and was very keen to increase every aspect of learning

Recommendations and next steps:

Some areas that still need improvement are fluency. I would therefore recommend that Keisuke Nakatsuka continues to take lessons, once or twice per week, in order to maintain the level of self confidence and ensure continuous improvement
