


**Comments on language progression and skills:**

**Recommendations and next steps:**

Some areas that still need improvement are fluency, business skills, pronunciation and intonation, vocabulary building, speaking and listening skills, conversational skills, grammatical accuracy. I would therefore recommend that Tatsuhiro Sato continues to take lessons, once or twice per week, in order to maintain the level of self confidence and ensure continuous improvement. I also suggest that Tatsuhiro Sato reads (language) as often as possible, newspapers and magazines, to improve reading skills, increase vocabulary and further improve grammar
