



Comments on language progression and skills:

Michael Clarke made good progress in confidence in speaking and listening and comprehension, vocabulary building / more sophisticated vocabulary / more extensive vocabulary, establishing greater grammatical control / improving grammatical accuracy / better use and understanding of grammar, pronunciation, word stressing and intonation, awareness of cultural issues

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:

Recommendations and next steps:

Some areas that still need improvement are business skills, writing skills, vocabulary building, grammatical accuracy, conversational skills. . . I also suggest that Michael Clarke reads (language) as often as possible, newspapers and magazines, to improve reading skills, increase vocabulary and further improve grammar
