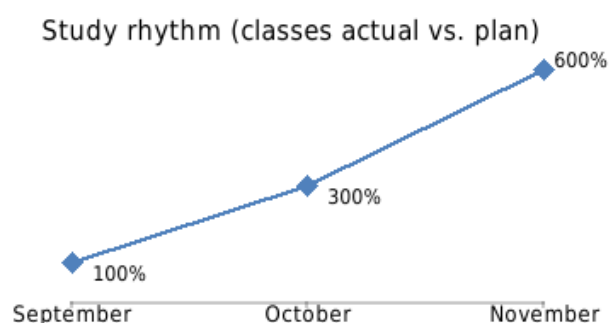
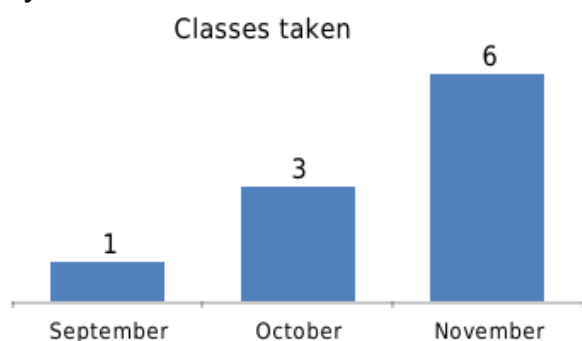

Comments on language progression and skills:

Shuntaro Nagasaka made good progress in confidence in speaking and listening and comprehension, writing skills, conversational skills, good degree of fluency / expressing opinions on a variety of subjects with a good degree of fluency, awareness of cultural issues, expressing with high level of self confidence

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:

Throughout the course Shuntaro Nagasaka made positive efforts to integrate the target language and concepts into the conversation, worked very hard to complete the tasks assigned, treated learning very seriously. Regarding the course homework Shuntaro Nagasaka worked hard and always made the assigned homework. Interaction and participation has been excellent attitude to learning. Recommendations and next steps:

Some areas that still need improvement are writing skills, grammatical accuracy.
