


Comments on language progression and skills:

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:

Interaction and participation has been very proactive in practicing in class and taking the advantage to speak more. Recommendations and next steps:

Some areas that still need improvement are fluency, grammatical accuracy, vocabulary building, business skills, pronunciation and intonation.
