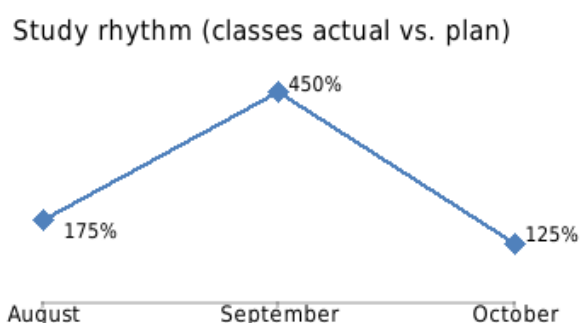
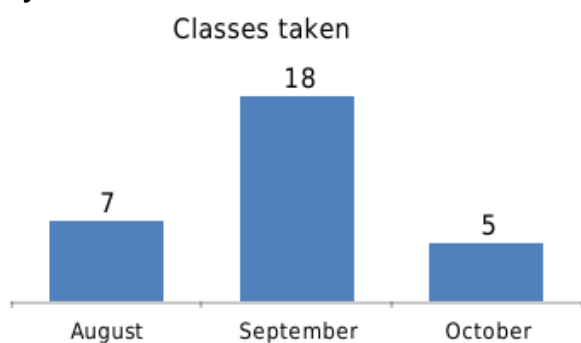

Comments on language progression and skills:

Yasuto Obuchi made good progress in confidence in speaking and listening and comprehension, conversational skills, vocabulary building / more sophisticated vocabulary / more extensive vocabulary, establishing greater grammatical control / improving grammatical accuracy / better use and understanding of grammar, good degree of fluency / expressing opinions on a variety of subjects with a good degree of fluency, expressing with high level of self confidence 'Yasuto has improved his overall confidence, speaking with much greater fluency and grammatical accuracy. He needs to continue to expand his general and business vocabulary in order to be more concise when speaking.'

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:
