


Comments and recommendations:

Comments on language progression and skills:

Stefano Totaro made good progress in confidence in speaking and listening and comprehension, conversational skills, vocabulary building / more sophisticated vocabulary / more extensive vocabulary, establishing greater grammatical control / improving grammatical accuracy / better use and understanding of grammar, pronunciation, word stressing and intonation, business skills, using a wider range of business expressions while practising business skills, good degree of fluency / expressing opinions on a variety of subjects with a good degree of fluency

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:

Throughout the course Stefano Totaro made positive efforts to integrate the target language and concepts into the conversation, treated learning very seriously, always prepared well for class

Recommendations and next steps:

Some areas that still need improvement are speaking and listening skills, writing skills, grammatical accuracy, business skills, pronunciation and intonation, vocabulary building. I would therefore recommend that Stefano Totaro continues to take lessons, once or twice per week, in order to maintain the level of self confidence and ensure continuous improvement. I also suggest that Stefano Totaro continues being exposed to (language) outside the class as much as possible
