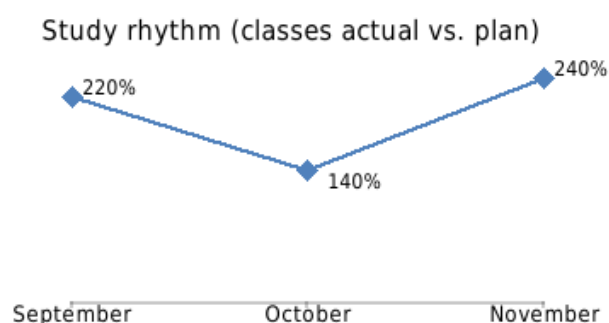
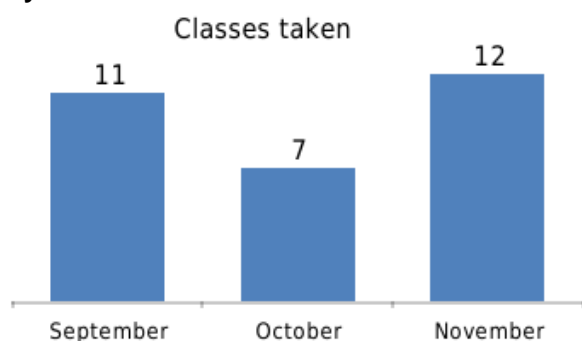

Comments on language progression and skills:

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:

Throughout the course Seiya Ishii made positive efforts to integrate the target language and concepts into the conversation, treated learning very seriously. Regarding the course homework Seiya Ishii made homework only from time to time

Recommendations and next steps:

Some areas that still need improvement are pronunciation and intonation, conversational skills, vocabulary building.
