


Comments on language progression and skills:

Liqun Huang made good progress in confidence in speaking and listening and comprehension, vocabulary building / more sophisticated vocabulary / more extensive vocabulary, establishing greater grammatical control / improving grammatical accuracy / better use and understanding of grammar, business skills, using a wider range of business expressions while practising business skills, awareness of cultural issues, expressing with high level of self confidence

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:

Throughout the course Liqun Huang made positive efforts to integrate the target language and concepts into the conversation, always prepared well for class, treated learning very seriously, worked very hard to complete the tasks assigned. Interaction and participation has been excellent attitude to learning. The student fully participated in the lessons and was very keen to increase every aspect of learning. Overall Liqun Huang was a very enthusiastic and avid learner -- a real pleasure to teach

Recommendations and next steps:

Some areas that still need improvement are fluency, pronunciation and intonation, vocabulary building. I would therefore recommend that Liqun Huang continues to take lessons, once or twice per week, in order to maintain the level of self confidence and ensure continuous improvement. I also suggest that Liqun Huang reads (language) as often as possible, newspapers and magazines, to improve reading skills, increase vocabulary and further improve grammar
