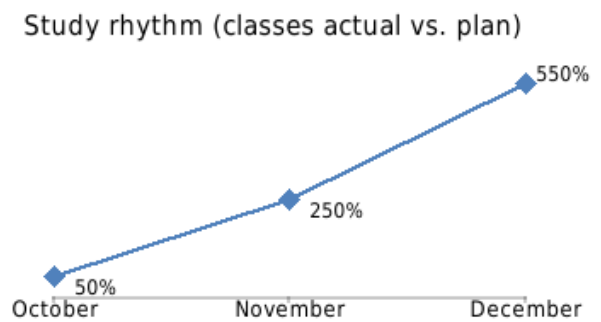
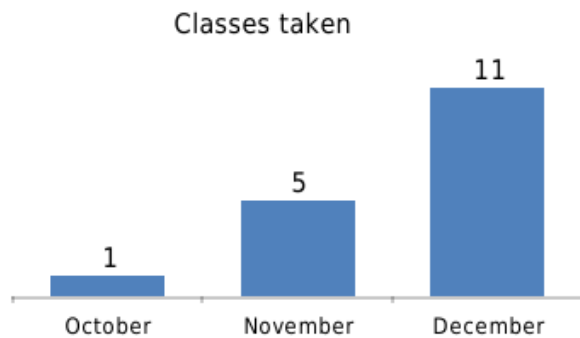

Comments on language progression and skills:

Denis Gaudfroy made good progress in confidence in speaking and listening and comprehension, conversational skills, vocabulary building / more sophisticated vocabulary / more extensive vocabulary, establishing greater grammatical control / improving grammatical accuracy / better use and understanding of grammar, pronunciation, word stressing and intonation, business skills, using a wider range of business expressions while practising business skills, good degree of fluency / expressing opinions on a variety of subjects with a good degree of fluency 'Denis has progressed well during the course and has significantly improved his confidence in the language. He expresses himself well and is much easier to engage him in conversations. He has also improved his grammatical accuracy and expanded his vocabulary range. The priority for him is to continue expanding his vocabulary range and speaking regularly to further improve his fluency.'
