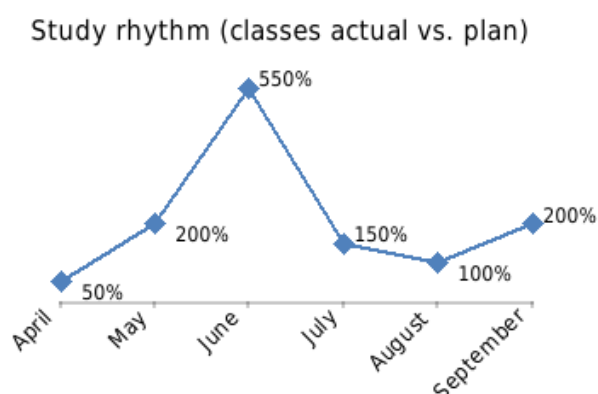
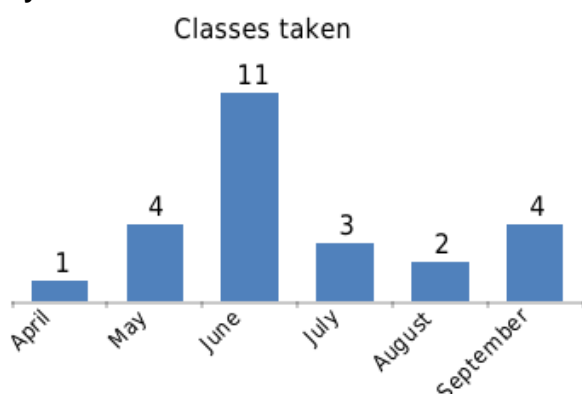

Comments on language progression and skills:

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:
