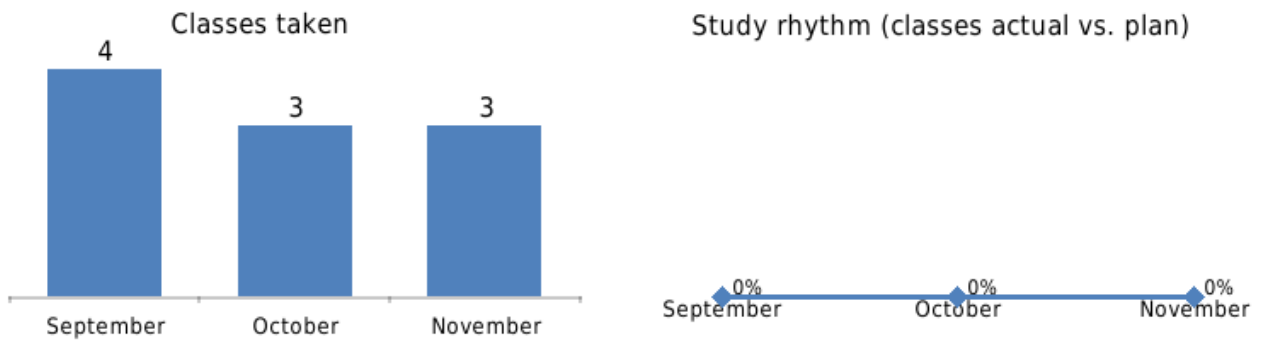

Comments on language progression and skills:

Recommendations and next steps:
