


Comments and recommendations:

Comments on language progression and skills:

Vitomir Samardzic made good progress in confidence in speaking and listening and comprehension, conversational skills, vocabulary building / more sophisticated vocabulary / more extensive vocabulary, establishing greater grammatical control / improving grammatical accuracy / better use and understanding of grammar, pronunciation, word stressing and intonation, good degree of fluency / expressing opinions on a variety of subjects with a good degree of fluency, expressing with high level of self confidence 'Vitomir has made very good progress during the course. At the beginning, he found it very difficult to express himself as was using incorrect tenses, lacked fluency, and had limited vocabulary. By the end of the course his tense usage improved, expanded his general vocabulary, and became more confident which helped him improve his fluency.'

Comments on student's attitude regarding learning:

Throughout the course Vitomir Samardzic treated learning very seriously. Regarding the course homework Vitomir Samardzic worked hard and always made the assigned homework. Interaction and participation has been excellent attitude to learning. The student fully participated in the lessons and was very keen to increase every aspect of learning. Overall Vitomir Samardzic was a very enthusiastic and avid learner -- a real pleasure to teach

Recommendations and next steps:

Some areas that still need improvement are conversational skills, vocabulary building, fluency, grammatical accuracy, speaking and listening skills. I would therefore recommend that Vitomir Samardzic continues to take lessons, once or twice per week, in order to maintain the level of self confidence and ensure continuous improvement. I also suggest that Vitomir Samardzic keep learning on a daily basis to accumulate knowledge and practice whenever there is a chance
