## Articles:Three little words

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## Articles: A, An, The

- "An" is used before a word that starts with a vowel sound for smoother pronunciation.
- Ex: "An apple" is easier to say than "A apple"
- "A" is used before words that start with a consonant sound
- Ex: "A telephone" is easier than "An telephone"
- Try the following exercise:

- apple
- banana
- office
- idea
- healthy person
- \_\_\_\_island
- university...\_educational institution

## English has exceptions!

- When the word starts with a <u>vowel sound</u> it usually has a <u>silent consonant</u> we use "An"
- Ex: An <u>honest</u> person.
- Note the "h" is silent.
- Try saying the following:
- an honor, an heir, an honest person, an hour

## Using:The

- We use "the" when we want to point something out <u>or</u> be specific. Most of the time "the" can be used before words that start with vowel or consonant sounds
- Ex: I want the big black bear.
- Ex: I want the apple, the red one, please.

- Try the following exercise using *the*:
